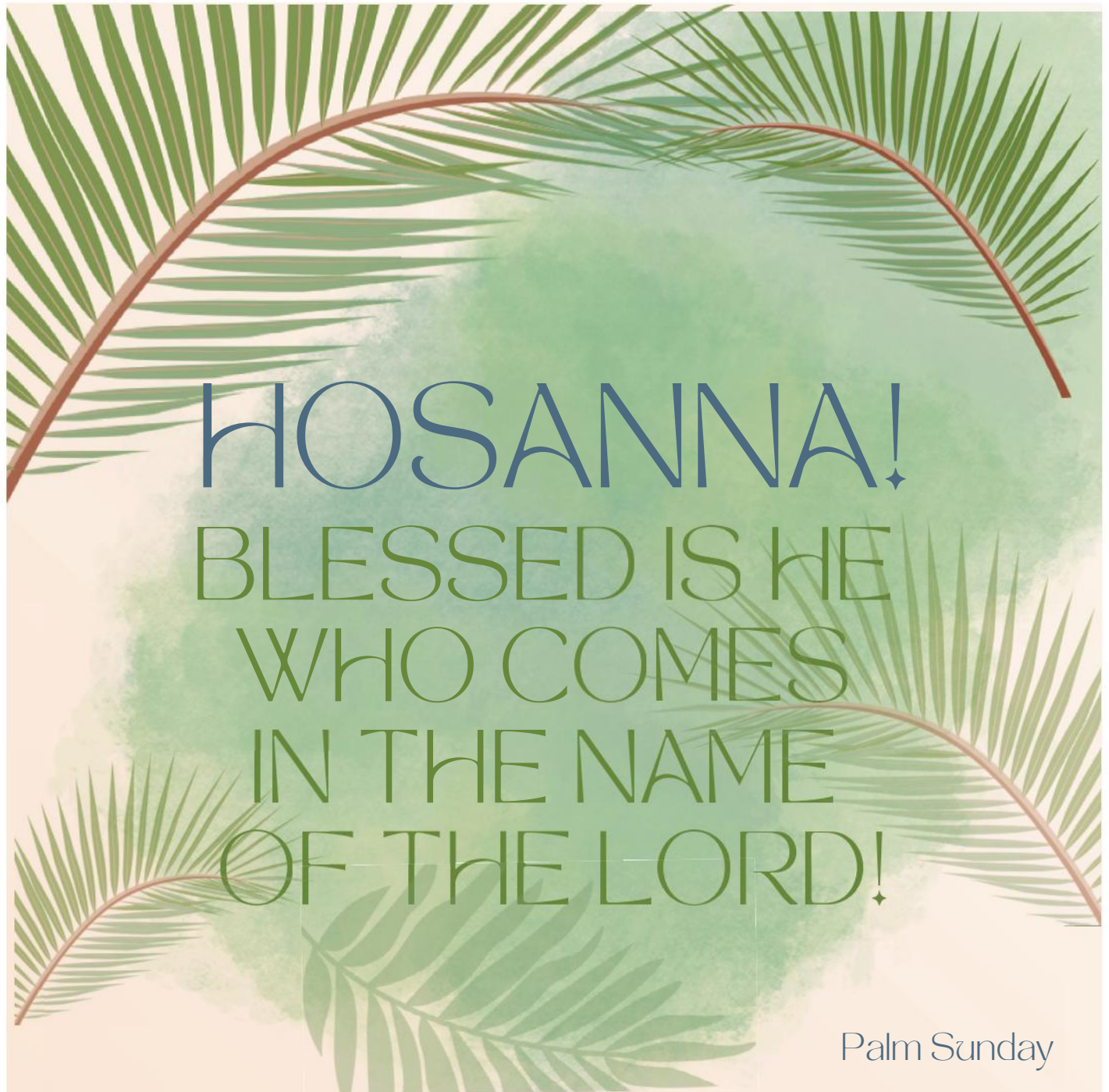

We are invited this week to be the companions of Jesus as we join Him in His entrance to Jerusalem. We will accompany our Lord at the Last Supper on Holy Thursday, and we will be invited to stay with Him in prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane. We will walk with Jesus as He makes His way to Calvary, carries His cross and is crucified, dies, and is placed in the tomb. We will experience the “great silence” as we anticipate His resurrection on Easter Sunday.

RAISE THE ROOF: CURRENT STATUS

A metal roof has reflective properties which can save us up to 25% on energy cost for our church building. Our energy bill for the church building averages \$5,000 a month. A metal roof could cut our energy bill cost as much as \$1,250 a month which comes out to \$15,000 a year. Over the course of a 40-year warranty, the metal roof could save us as much as \$600,000. This is an attractive benefit to replacing our shingle roof with a metal roof.

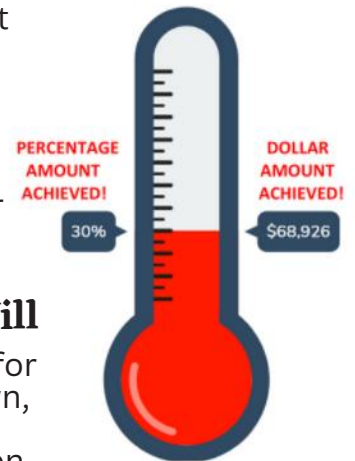

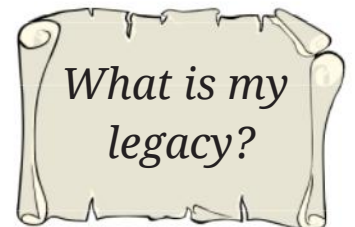

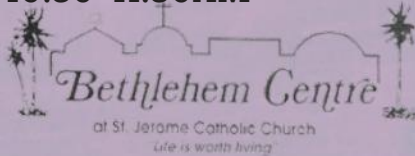

Lifeline Ministries

Last week Lifeline served 135 families comprised of 499 people. Parishioners donated 250 bags of food for a total of 936 so far this month. We appreciate the strong response to the recent email blasts requesting food donations.

On Saturday, Lifeline was the beneficiary of a large food donation through Vacation Donations. Vacation Donations is a new not-for-profit community resource in Indian Rocks Beach which encourages vacationers and property managers to donate food to local food pantries which travelers can't or don't take back with them. Their motto is "After a stay, give it away." The food donated this week came from vacationers at the Reef Club condominiums in IRB.
