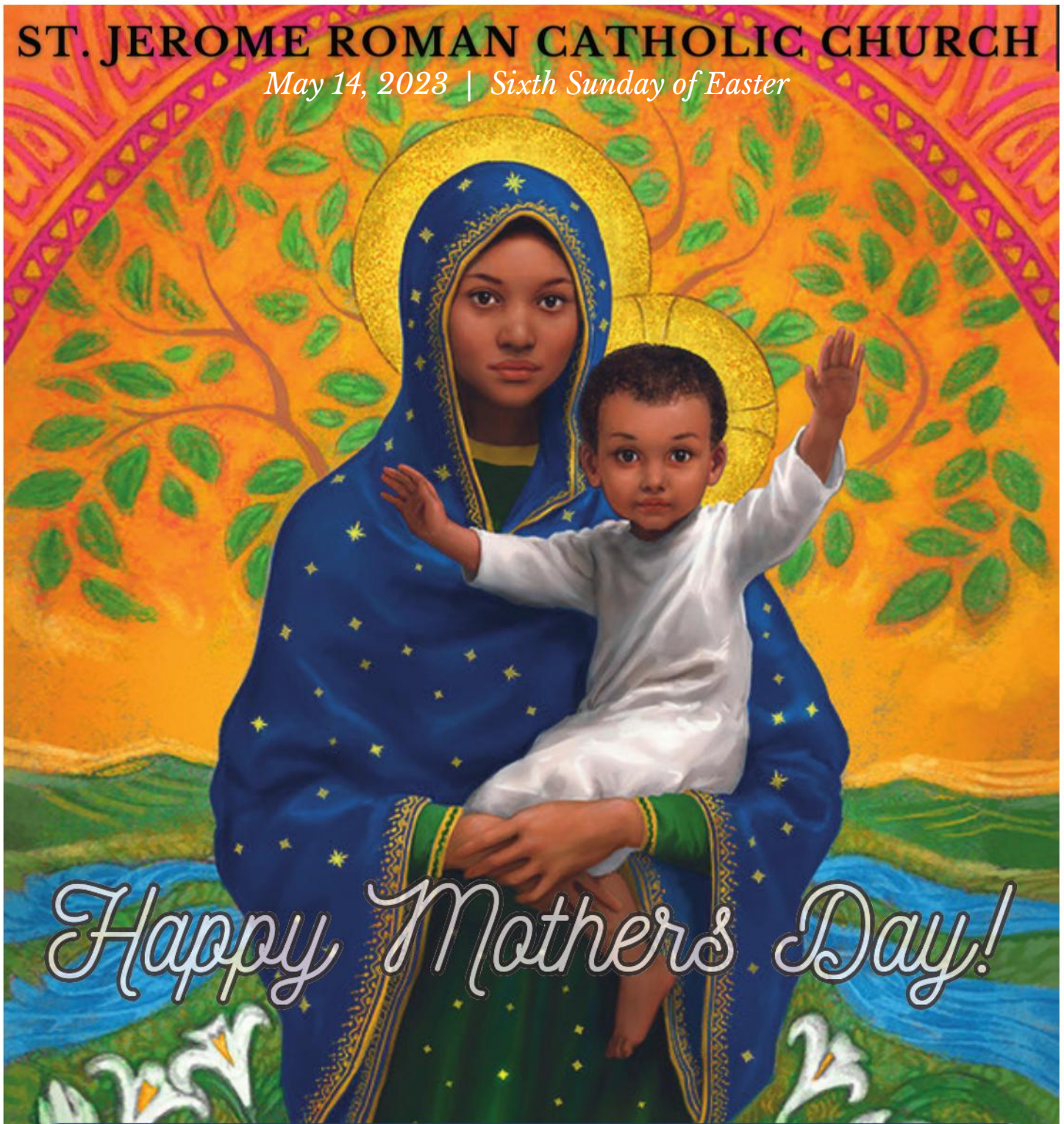

Our Church building and Gathering Space is all ready for the red terrazzo work this week. We thank Karcher Construction, our maintenance team, and the many volunteers for the hard work that has been put into getting our church ready for this major job. During our preparations, Bruce and Mike discovered several areas around the sanctuary where the existing red terrazzo was not even attached to the concrete below. This presents a major safety hazard, and further confirms why we need to expeditiously complete this job. This week Exclusive Surfaces, the floor company we have hired, will arrive to begin demoing the existing red terrazzo in the church and gathering space. We will continue to give updates throughout this process.

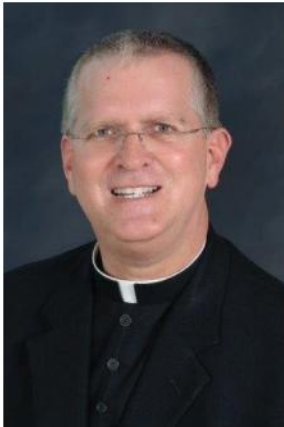

RAISE THE ROOF: CURRENT STATUS

The proposed roof for the church building will be a standing seam metal roof that will provide a useful life in excess of forty years. One of the biggest benefits of standing seam roofing is the hidden fastener system it uses. The hidden (or concealed fasteners), refers to the clips, screws or nails being hidden from view on the installed standing seam roof. A key benefit of hidden fasteners is not puncturing the standing seam metal panel itself, nor is it exposed to weather which could cause them to fail over time. This usually means the standing seam metal roof has a higher level of protection from the elements, will require less maintenance, and will provide a more attractive and appealing look for the standing seam roof.

We are working hard towards the goal of **\$1.4 million**. Thanks for pledging today so we can quickly complete this needed project!
