

Mission Co-Op 2023: Archdiocese of Imphal

St. Jerome has been paired this year with the mission diocese of Imphal in the State of Manipur in Northeast India. It is home to 34 tribes of Mongolian origin. Ever since first Catholic baptism in 1952, Catholic population has grown up to 101,283 as of now. The diocese has 45 parishes and 8 Mission Centers with 174 priests including 114 indigenous tribal priests.

The growth of the Church has always been accompanied by various challenges and persecutions during the past decades. Between 1990 – 2001, six of our young and dynamic missionaries were killed for witnessing the gospel. Sadly speaking, the State of Manipur witnessed the worst religious persecution against the minority Christians from the majority Hindus (Meities) in May 2023 which was unprecedented in the history of the Church in Manipur. In the sporadic violence that followed accounted for the killing of over 1000 tribal Christians, including women and children. Nearly 50000 fled their villages as most of their homes are either partially or completely burnt down and have taken refuge in nearby military camps and school buildings run by the churches. Several of our churches were vandalized and at least three churches are completely burnt down by violent mobs, causing widespread damages to properties worth millions of dollars.

At present, Mass is conducted in school buildings. It will take several years to rebuild the damaged churches and institutions and also to alleviate the sufferings of the affected tribal communities through massive relief and rehabilitation program. We have confidence in the resilience of our communities and the strength of their faith. We look forward to your participation in our diocesan effort to provide the much needed relief to the suffering people with the help of your generous support and prayers. Fr. Augustine Mailadiyil from the archdiocese will preach at all masses.




