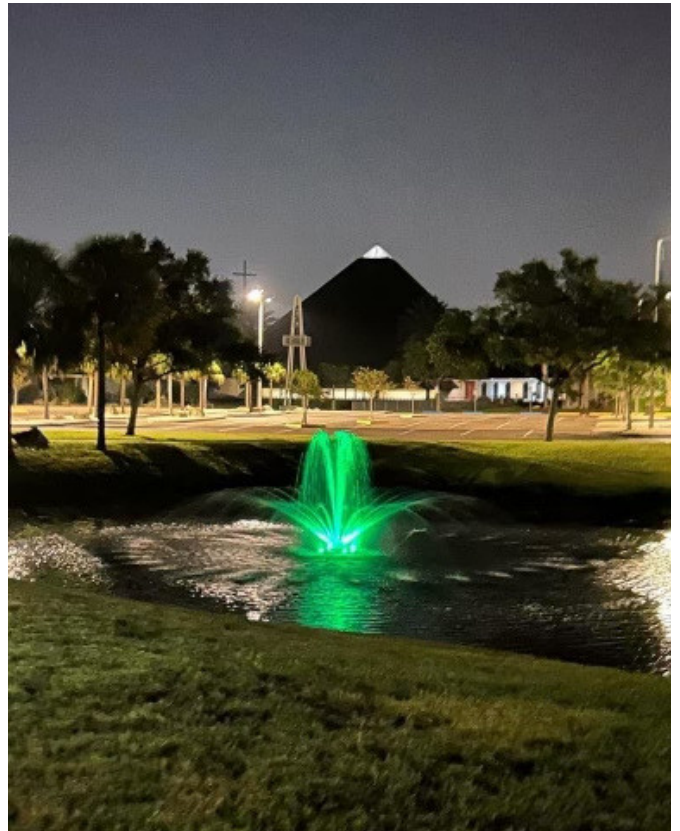
Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Two months ago, with the help of a generous donor and a couple of volunteers, we were able to embark on a special project to add two fountains and improve the lighting at the front of St. Jerome's campus. There were three goals of this project.

First, we wanted to improve lighting at the front of campus. The lightbulbs on each post at each entrance have been changed to LED. The fountains have four bulbs and shine brightly at night. The sidewalk down the middle will soon be illuminated again as well once we get the new control box and timer. Second, we wanted to improve the circulation of the water which reduces algae growth and helps nourish the aquatic life. The agitated waters and increased oxygen levels also deter mosquito activity in the ponds. Lastly, the lights and fountains add immediate curb appeal and aesthetics to the campus. We are thankful to all who made this possible, especially the donor who made this contribution in honor of all the religious priests and sisters who have and continue to be beacons of light pointing us to the Light of the World, Jesus Christ.

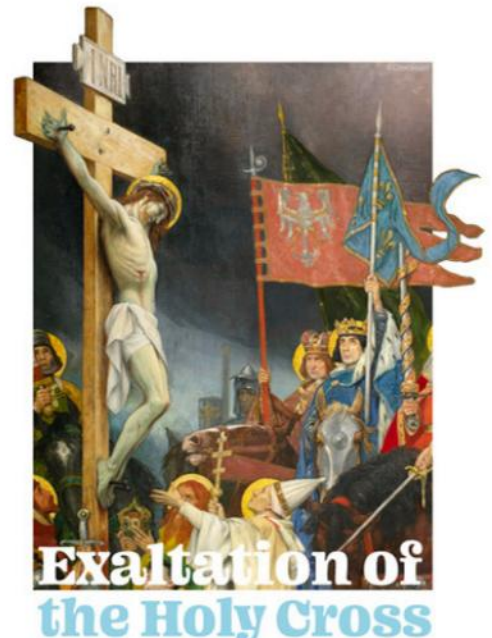

ADULT CONFIRMATION CLASS AND CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Are you an adult who has not celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation? Adult Catholics (ages 15 years and older) who have been baptized, received First Eucharist and are practicing their faith but have not celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation are Invited to participate in a preparation program.

In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the individual's baptism is reinforced and sealed. This sacrament, like baptism, may only be celebrated once. It is closely linked with baptism in that there is an anointing with oil (Chrism), laying on of hands, and a special activity of the Holy Spirit. When celebrated apart from Baptism and First Communion, the bishop, or a priest designated by him, is the minister of Confirmation.

The preparation program consists of six sessions in which you, the adult, will be advised of the process for this preparation and what is required of you. Begins October 12th!

Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time: Not My Problem

Ever notice how people today like to ignore the evil in the world? People will witness a mugging and not bother to call the police. We see television stories of children starving in poor countries and say, "Not my problem." The readings for this Sunday challenge this attitude.

As a prophet, Ezekiel is to proclaim God's word of repentance to the wicked. The Lord tells Ezekiel that he will be held responsible for the death of the wicked if he refuses to warn against the evil they are doing. In the Gospel, Jesus describes how his disciples should confront the sinner. His words teach us something about our duty to the sinner. First, he tells us that sin is our problem, and when we see it we need to take the initiative to stop it. Second, he tells us we need not feel alone in this duty. When the sinner refuses to listen, we bring in help. In fact, this command is meant for the whole church. Third, he tells us to be persistent; don't give up on someone too easily.

So what about that line about treating the sinner who refuses to listen as a Gentile or tax collector? On the one hand, the sinner should be excluded from the church, excommunicated, if he doesn't repent. On the other hand, Jesus never rejected tax collectors (like Matthew himself, who wrote this Gospel) or Gentiles. He said he came to call sinners, to save them. He loves sinners. And that is the reason we are to confront them—not to punish them, but to love them. As we see in the second reading, "love is the fulfillment of the law."

That's why the Gospel ends with Jesus' words about disciples praying together. When we think we cannot make a sinner repent, we remember that only God can do that. We can pray for sinners, including ourselves, and ask God to renew them in the Spirit. For God never forces a person to repent. God invites with love, especially the love Jesus showed by dying on the cross. May we all learn to fight evil with love!
