

# FROM THE PARISH MANAGER

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

**Happy Feast!** This Sunday is our annual St. Jerome Feast Day and International Festival at 1:30PM in the Parish Center. I wish everyone a happy feast day and invite you to join us in celebration. Below is a brief biography of our patron saint. An expanded version is on our website.



Saint Jerome was born in Strido, Dalmatia (Croatia) in 347. After being educated by his father, he was sent to Rome to study classical literature and rhetoric. While there, he was baptized by Pope Liberius in 366. While in Rome, he eagerly studied Greek, Latin, history and philosophy and built his own library, diligently copying most of the works he read. Leaving Rome in his early twenties, he traveled to Trier in Gaul and transcribed the works of St. Hilary. After returning to Aquileia, he continued his theological studies. About 373, he made a pilgrimage to the east, arranging to take in cities in Asia Minor. Reaching Antioch in Syria, he arranged to stay for several months. There he pursued humanistic and monastic studies, although he soon turned from the classics to Christian writings. Then he moved to the desert of Chalcia, southeast of Antioch, living as a hermit for five years. Now he included his much-loved study of Scripture and copy work. As a young man, Jerome did not easily forget the delights of Rome and found himself homesick for a world of thought, study, and discussion. However, he had a deep spiritual experience in a dream and was accused of being a "Ciceronian, not a Christian". He then decided to study Hebrew to overcome this temptation.

He translated Scripture directly from Hebrew and organized a workshop dedicating himself to the Bible and Theology; however, this dedication was not always kept. It was in Bethlehem that he began his productive literary period, both his Biblical commentaries and his work on the Latin Bible. In addition to this work, he helped establish monasteries. The needy were not neglected and his work on Scripture continued. Jerome translated most of the Old Testament from Hebrew and some from Greek. His greatest achievement was, of course, the translation of the Bible, still used by the Catholic Church today. He also wrote Scriptural commentaries, biographies, a history of writers and corresponded greatly. In addition to his Biblical work, he wrote extensively on varied topics, translations, heresies and commentary including all the prophets, books of the Bible and polemical treatises. Saint Jerome died in 419 and was buried under the Church of the Nativity close to the site of the birth of Jesus. Now his relics rest in the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore in Rome. In 1989, he became a Father, and Doctor of the Church. His feast day is observed on September 30th. He is the patron saint of librarians.

St. Jerome reminds us that "ignorance of scripture is ignorance of Christ." This week, I challenge you to spend a little extra time reading the Bible, whether it be five minutes a day, or one day for 20 or 30 minutes. You can even stop by the Adoration Chapel to pray if it helps you. Whenever you choose to do it, know that Christ is deeply longing to encounter you in the Scriptures.

Before you read and pray, perhaps start with this simple prayer, "Come, Holy Spirit, please speak to me. Your servant is listening."

## The Seven Sorrows of Mary - A Reflection by Erica Tighe Campbell (Artistan, Be A Heart)

For years I ran from experiencing any sort of negative feeling. I drowned it out with alcohol - just a couple of drinks a night. I wanted life to only be happy. I longed for a time without sorrow and pain. I ran and ran. I threw a fit because I thought that if I followed "the rules" and was "good" then there would only be joy. But as I got sober and had to face life as life was, I came to understand that there is no joy without sorrow. Living a life with God means turning our face toward the sad things, toward the hard things, toward the pain. God doesn't promise that life will be free of difficulties, God only promises that we won't be alone in it.

And here is our mother. Jesus's mother. A mother who knows the depths of sorrows as she watched her beautiful son be killed on a cross. She watched the sweat and blood drip from his body. This body that was birthed from her own. She knows deeply the mother's greatest sorrow. She sits with us. She is here today just as she was then.

It takes deep courage to allow ourselves to feel the sorrowful things. It takes deep courage to not run and drown it all with vices. It takes deep courage to say "this is really sad and I am sad" and (this month) on the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, we are reminded that we do not suffer alone.



Our Lady of Sorrows, pray for us. (The iris is known as the sword lily and is associated with Our Lady of Sorrows)

- Crucifixion and Death of Jesus (John 19:25-30) The body of Jesus taken from the Cross (Psalm 130; Luke 23:50-54; John 19:31-37)
  - The burial of Jesus (Isaiah 53:8; Luke 23:50-56; John 19:38-42; Mark 15:40-47)



## ADULT CONFIRMATION CLASS AND CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Are you an adult who has not celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation? Adult Catholics (ages 15 years and older) who have been baptized, received First Eucharist and are practicing their faith but have not celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation are Invited to participate in a preparation program.



In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the individual's baptism is reinforced and sealed. This sacrament, like baptism, may only be celebrated once. It is closely linked with baptism in that there is an anointing with oil (Chrism), laying on of hands, and a special activity of the Holy Spirit. When celebrated apart from Baptism and First Communion, the bishop, or a priest designated by him, is the minister of Confirmation.

The preparation program consists of six sessions in which you, the adult, will be advised of the process for this preparation and what is required of you. Begins October 12th!






