This year, World Mission Sunday, the annual, worldwide Eucharist celebration for the missions of the Church, will be next weekend, October 21-22, 2023. Each year on this special day, we are reminded that the Church, established by Christ passing it onto his apostles, is missionary by its nature.

Pope Francis' 2023 World Missionary Sunday theme is

Hearts on fire, feet on the move, based on the story of the disciples on their way to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35). In his message,

the Holy Father quotes his predecessor, Pope Benedict XVI, who stated: "We cannot keep to ourselves the love we celebrate in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. By its very nature, it asks us to be communicated to everyone [...] An authentically Eucharistic Church is a missionary Church" (Post-Synodal Apostolic Exhortation Sacramentum Caritatis, 84)

In 1926, Pope Pius XI instituted World Mission Sunday. On the next-to-last Sunday in October each year, this observance is an effort of the entire Church to help over 1,100 dioceses that cannot sustain themselves because they are too poor, young, and/or actively persecuted.

Your gifts support and sustain priests, religious, and lay pastoral leaders in mission dioceses in Asia, Africa, the Pacific Islands and parts of Latin America and Europe as they proclaim the Gospel, build the Church, serve the poor, and speak of our shared faith in all corners of the world.

Please be assured of my gratitude for your prayerful support of those in mission territories and for your generous participation in the missionary work of the Church.


