

Our A/C Company, Griffin Services, discovered a few weeks ago that we have a couple of major repairs and a couple smaller repairs we need to complete on our Church A/C Chiller. The major repairs include replacing the second compressor and the condenser fan motor. In total these repairs will cost a little over \$30,000. While this is a lot of money, this will get our chiller in optimal shape. Griffin Services is confident our chiller will be in good shape for several years after this work and the work we have completed in the past couple of years. They have been very honest and affordable compared to our previous vendor. To help lessen the financial burden, we have decided to sell the 2005 G35 Infiniti that was previously owned by the late Msgr. Dacian Dee. It has been lightly used by the parish and made sense to sell. The proceeds of this sale will go toward this important repair. We thank you for trusting us as we work to ensure needed maintenance gets taken care of in a timely manner for the betterment of our faith community.


