



LIFE TEEN

ABOUT THE LENTEN SEASON AND OUR CATECHUMENS/ELECT

Every year at the Easter Vigil Mass, we welcome into full communion with the church, through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist our catechumens: the adults who have undergone a period of catechization and are ready to continue on their faith journey. These catechumens were first presented to the parish community during the Rite of Acceptance at the 10:45AM Mass. Since then, they have met weekly with their sponsors/godparents and our OCIA catechists in preparation for the sacraments of initiation.

On February 18th, they were presented again to the congregation at the 10:45 Mass, and on the same afternoon to Bishop Gregory Parkes at the cathedral during the Rite of Election and were known as the elect. Then on the third, fourth, and fifth Sundays of Lent, we will conduct the Rite of Scrutiny. During the Rites of Scrutiny, the elect and the congregation as a whole, at the 10:45AM Mass, are invited to silently examine their consciences and seek repentance from sin.

During these Sundays at the 10:45 Mass, even though we are in a Cycle B year, the readings are from Cycle A (John 4, 9, and 11). This is because these Gospels, which deal with the Samaritan woman at the well, the healing of the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus, reflect the meaning of these rituals and the journey of the elect.

- Coming to faith and living water
 Opening our eyes to see Christ-like-ways, and
- Awakening to éternal life

During these rites, the term exorcism is used. An exorcism is the act of liberating persons (the elect in this case) from the power of evil through prayer and symbolic actions such as the laying on of hands by the celebrant. These are important rites that symbolize the passage of these converts into a new life as full communicants. Therefore, they are also important to the entire community. During the third, fourth, and fifth week of Lent, if you do not attend the 10:45 Mass, please be aware of the Rites of Scrutiny and what the Elect (Catechumens) are experiencing. Please read the Gospels of Cycle A and in spirit walk with them. Pray that they will continue to find spiritual strength in our Lord Christ who is the way, the truth, and the life so they may deepen their resolve to complete their conversion.

RAISE THE ROOF UPDATE

As of January 31st, our roof fund is now sitting at \$1,059,714.88. We are blessed to have the Diocese be the financial record keepers of our campaign.

We are working hard towards the goal of **\$1.4 million.** Thanks for pledging today so we can quickly complete this much needed project and replace the Church roof.



Prior to starting our campaign, our Building and Maintenance Committee determined that replacing our shingled church roof with a metal roof was our best choice for several reasons. First, the warranty for a metal roof is at least 40 years, which is over double the lifespan of a shingle roof. Second, metal roofs withstand a category 4 hurricane with 150 mph winds and 180 mph gusts. Third, metal roofs have reflective properties making them energy efficient which can reduce cooling costs by as much as 25%.


Save the Date for VBS!
