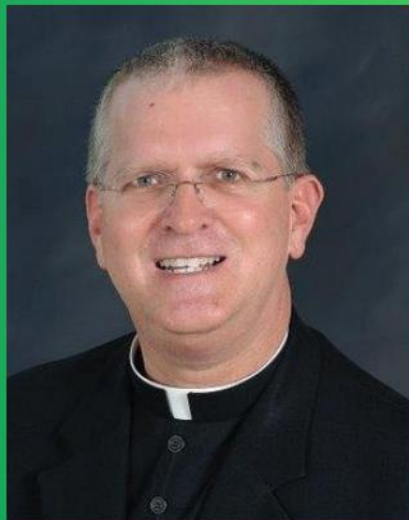

Dear Friends,

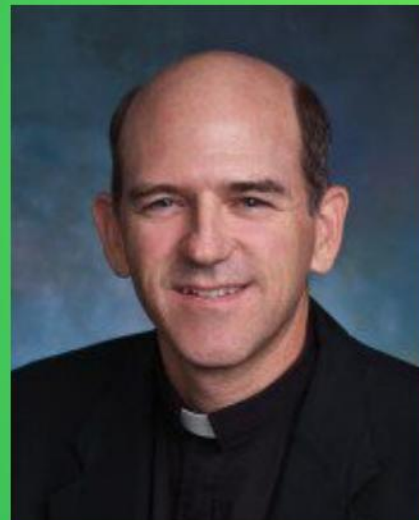

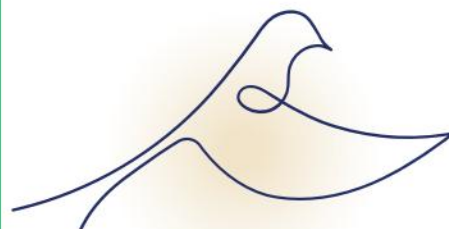

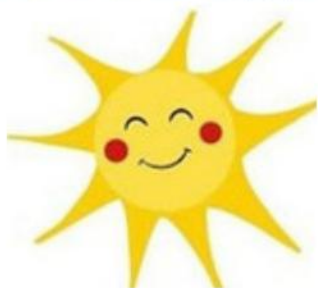

Lifeline Ministries

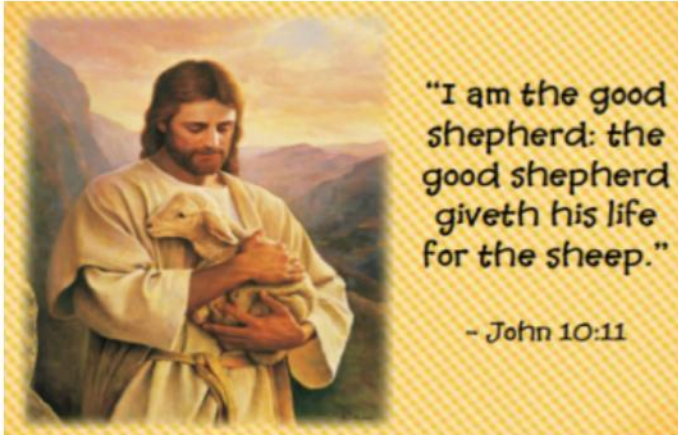
Last week, Lifeline served 88 families comprised of 270 people, and parishioners donated 76 bags of food for total of 199 so far this month.
