He is also a founding member of Liber Christo, a movement in conjunction with Fr. Chad Ripberger, SMD which provides tools and resources for priests and laity working in Catholic exorcism and deliverance.

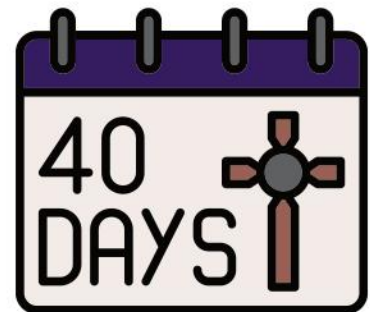

ALL DAY EUCHARISTIC ADORATION ON LENTEN 1ST FRIDAYS



We will offer all-day Eucharistic Adoration on the next 1st Friday of Lent season: **Friday, April 4th.**

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will occur in the Chapel after the 9am Mass and Stations of the Cross. Benediction will occur in the Chapel at 6:45pm immediately preceding our 7pm Stations of the Cross.

Since Our Eucharistic Lord will be exposed on the altar from morning until evening, **it is essential that we have a sufficient number of Eucharistic adorers to ensure that the Blessed Sacrament is not left unattended.**

There should be a minimum number of 2 adorers present at any given time.

Lenten Guidelines for Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. (From USCCB)

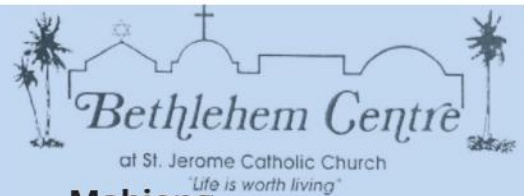

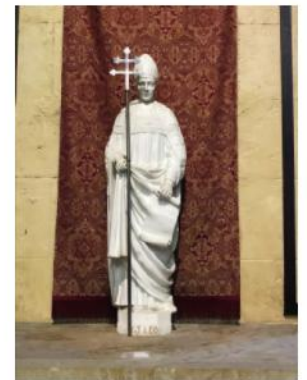
Adventures at Saint Leo Abbey
