Saint Spotlights: St. Joseph and St. Patrick

This week we celebrate two popular powerhouses in our faith, St. Joseph and St. Patrick.

March 17 - St. Patrick - The famous bishop in Ireland, Patrick was actually from Britain and was captured and brought to Ireland, where he spread the gospel until his release. Amazingly, after he was released, his passion for the souls of the Irish people eventually led him back their to help them know Christ and see to follow him. He is often pictured with a three leaf clover, a symbol he is said to have used to teach how the Trinity is three persons in one God.

March 19 - St. Joseph - Famous for no recorded words in scripture, Joseph is often renowned for his quiet strength and faithfulness. Joseph was holy in the ordinary, a faithful and loving husband to Mary and foster father to Jesus. St. Joseph is often shown with a staff, a lily, and a level, to symbolize his strength in journey, a lily for purity, and a level for his skills as a builder.

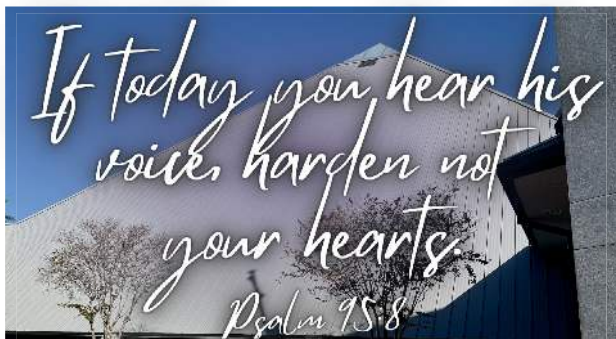

Regulations on Fasting & Abstinence

The custom of self-denial is meant to simplify one’s life so that freed
from distraction, we may hear and respond to God’s continued call to
conversion and holiness.

FASTING is to be observed on Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18 to 59 years inclusive.
On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may
be taken according to one’s needs, but together should not equal another full meal. Liquids are allowed.

ABSTINENCE from meat is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age or older. Ash
Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday are days of abstinence.

*PASTORAL NOTE: Persons unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious
reasons may practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.*

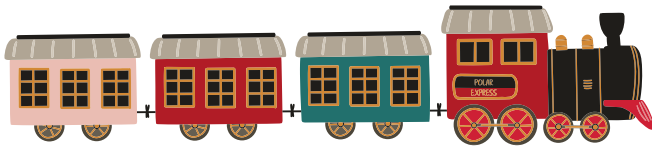

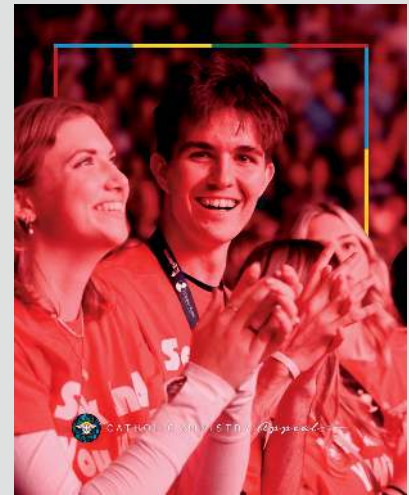

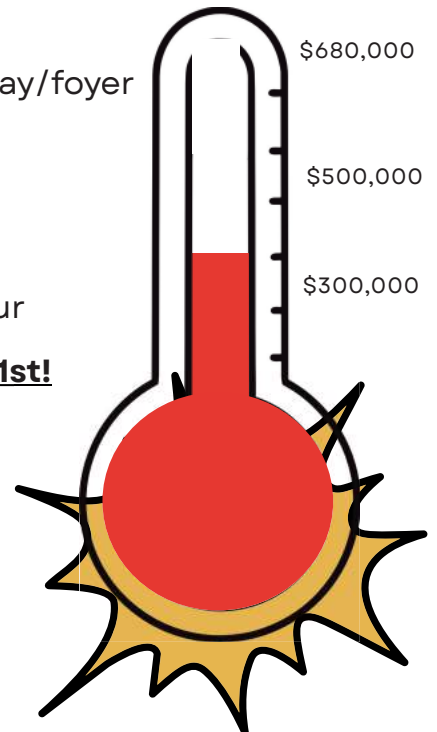
The updates include the following highlights:

Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12

In Caravaggio's Light

Did you know there is an incredible exhibit right now at the Museum of Fine Arts in downtown St. Petersburg that features a large amount of Catholic art? Until March 22nd, 2026, you can travel back to the Baroque period, and even further, to the life of Jesus and the apostles.

A unique, foundational aspect of Caravaggio's art is that he begins not with a white canvas, but approaches from black. This creates a dramatic play with light and shadow that makes his subjects particularly realistic. Though he had no students, several artists were inspired by his style in the period, and this exhibit features many such works.



There is a wall featuring striking portraits of five apostles and their common symbols, which are often considered the tools of their martyrdom. Those who have visited our Cathedral, St. Jude the Apostle, may especially enjoy seeing St. Jude and his axe, St. Paul and a sword and bible, and even St. Jerome on another wall compiling the Latin vulgate, the first compilation of scripture all in one language. There is even a shocking depiction of St. Bartholomew, who tradition tells us was flayed to death, looking boldly and directly at the viewer.

Other powerful pieces include St. Mary Magdalene, "Apostle to the Apostles," reclining in a chair with her arm on a skull, a common symbol of "Memento Mori," which means "remember your death". This could be a nod to her role of finding the resurrected Christ in the tomb or to the call to turn from sin and follow the gospel. But perhaps the most striking part of this painting is her tender, loving gaze at the crucifix, Her line of vision is directly fixed on Jesus' eyes on the crucifix, showing great love and affection for Him. We recall how Mary of Magdala was a close, dear friend of Jesus'. Would that our hearts also swell and desire such a friendship with our loving Savior!

There are many more pieces to look for: Jesus playing with his cousin, John the Baptist, together with Mary; a beautiful Nativity, Judith, and the deeply vulnerable *Jesus Christ Carried to the Tomb* by Battistello, and more.

The exhibit ends soon; don't delay your visit! It's a great opportunity this Lent to slow down for an hour or two and encounter Jesus in the good, true, and beautiful. -SHW

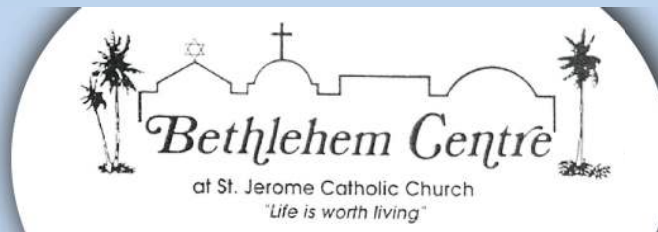

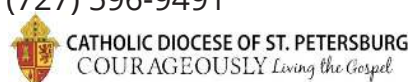
