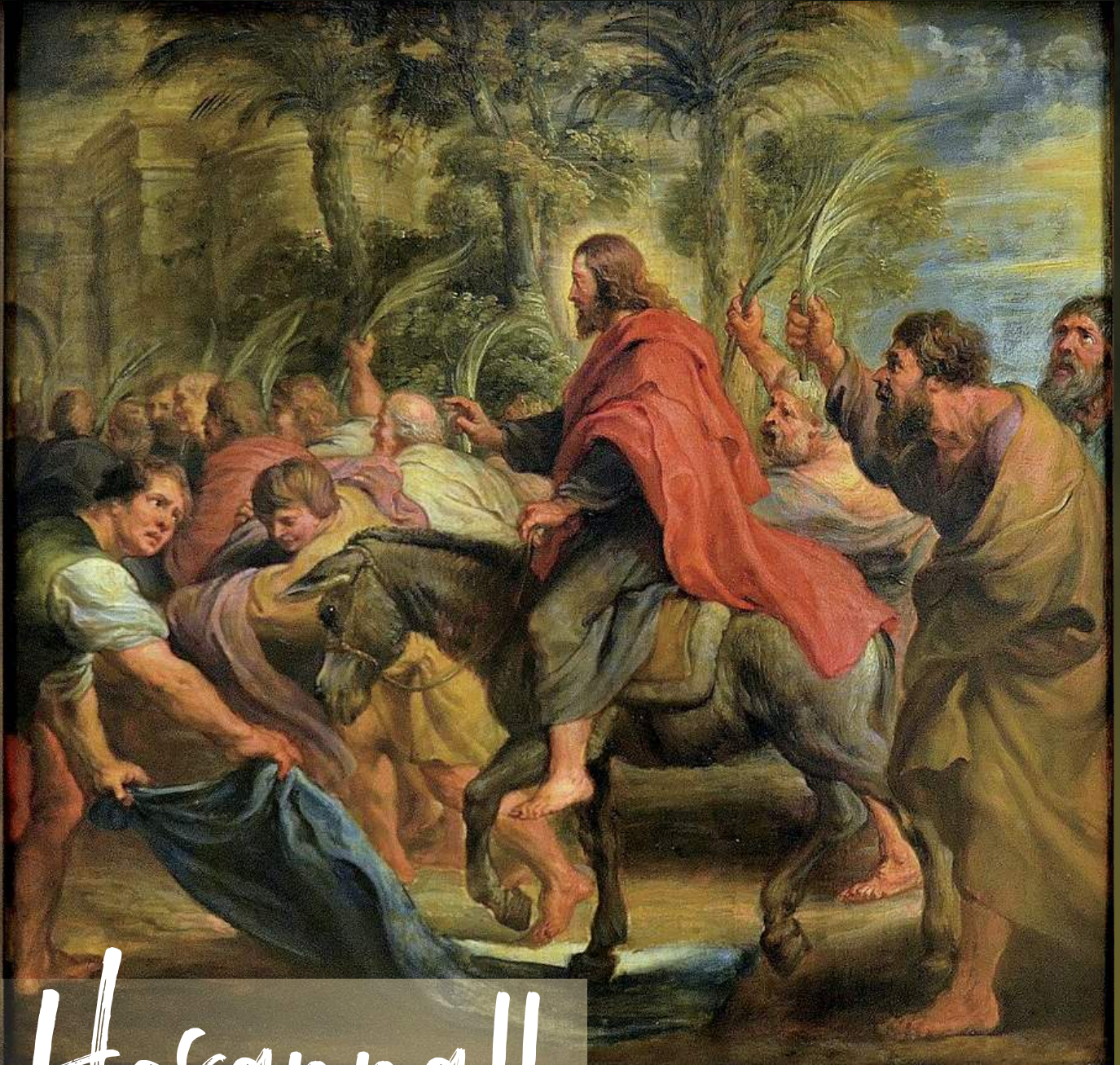

Regulations on Fasting & Abstinence

The custom of self-denial is meant to simplify one's life so that freed from distraction, we may hear and respond to God's continued call to conversion and holiness.

FASTING is to be observed on Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18 to 59 years inclusive. On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together should not equal another full meal. Liquids are allowed.

ABSTINENCE from meat is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age or older. Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday are days of abstinence.

PASTORAL NOTE: Persons unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons may practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.

- And more!

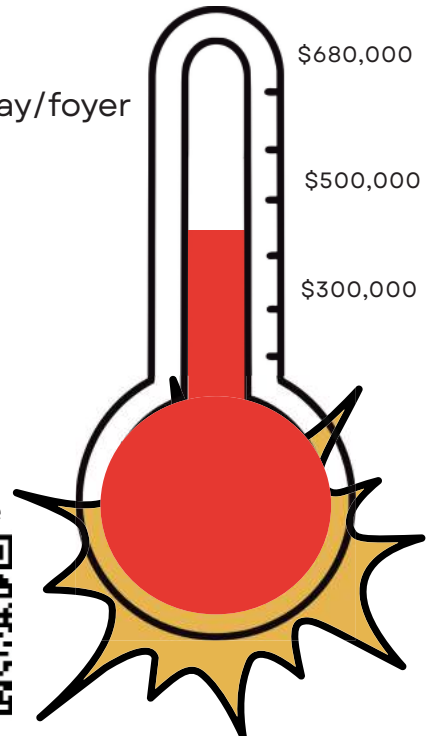
We have raised \$396,496.82 as of 3/17/26, and are over halfway to our goal of \$680,000.

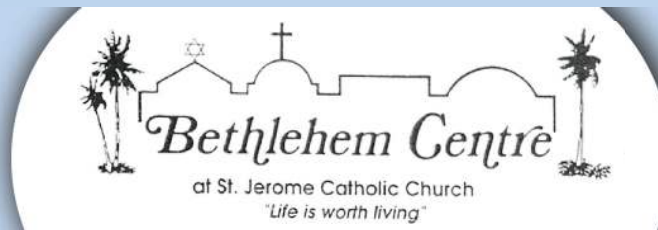
