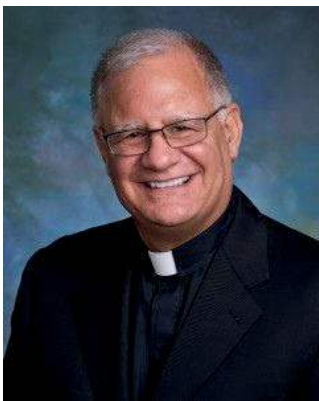
Dear Parishioners,

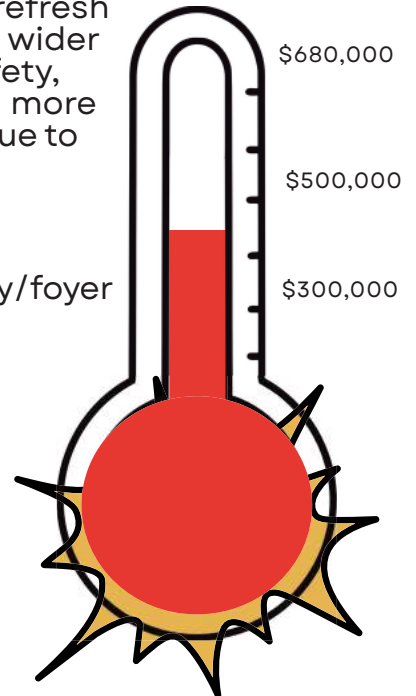
The updates include:

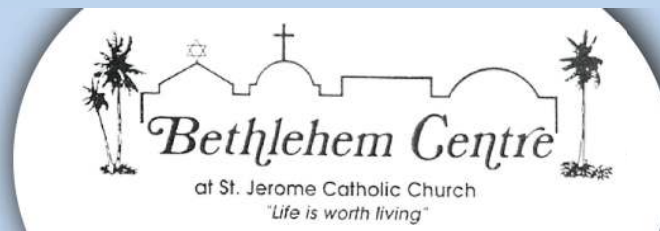


The Knights meet the second Wednesday of each month in the Parish Center. We are very active in serving the community, our parish, and growing in faith.

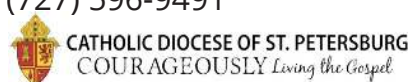
